Behavioral Health Urgent Care Services

Immediate Support, No Appointment Needed!

St. Clair County Community Mental Health offers walk-in services for individuals experiencing a behavioral health crisis or those in need of rapid access to care.

Services Include:

- Mental health crisis assessment & stabilization
- Brief counseling and emotional support
- Suicide Prevention and safety planning
- Substance use crisis intervention
- Referral and linkage to ongoing care

Who Can Use Crisis Services?

- Youth, adults, and families in emotional or psychological crisis
- Individuals experiencing anxiety, depression, suicidal thoughts, to substance-related distress
- Those who need help now but don't require emergency room or inpatient care

What to Expect:

When you arrive, you'll be greeted by trained professionals, social workers, clinicians, or peer support specialists who will listen, assess your needs, and work with you on a path forward.

No Insurance? No problem!

For those who qualify, SCCCMH provides services regardless of insurance or ability to pay, utilizing a sliding fee scale.
