III. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR UPDATE – D. Johnson

Executive Director Johnson introduced a new procedure to ensure quality assurance. Supervisory staff will place up to five phone calls monthly to individuals served to inquire if their needs are being met. Phone call recipients will be at random. Feedback on this new implementation is welcomed.

B. Service Updates

CMH is still providing services in-person and virtually through the COVID-19 pandemic. Group services are mostly virtual and have been going well. There has been an increase in virtual attendance in all service areas. Community Integrated Services (CIS) Program are conducting services one-on-one, visiting the group homes to complete services as needed. Intakes are also increasing.

C. Vaccine Updates

There are approximately 170 staff who have received the first Covid-19 vaccination. There are approximately 25 staff in the queue to receive their first vaccination, and approximately 60 staff who are "undecided" at this time. Genoa Pharmacy has offered assistance in group home vaccine administration. Please note the vaccine is not mandatory for staff.

V. CCBHC UPDATE – K. Gallagher

Through CCBHC, the Agency has partnered with Michigan State University for various virtual classes offered to individuals served and community members. Yoga classes are also continued. All classes are virtual and free of charge. Information will be emailed to the council.

The Agency is also anticipating hiring a new phlebotomist.


