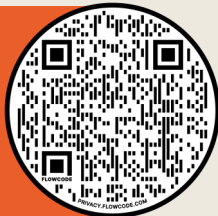

One in five Americans have a mental illness and many are reluctant to seek or may not know where to find help. **Mental Health First Aid (MHFA)** helps to start the conversation about mental health and substance use by teaching people how to identify, understand and respond to signs and symptoms of a mental health or substance use challenge. The evidence shows that MHFA builds mental health literacy and reduces the fear or hesitation to take action.

Mental Health First Aid:

- Decreases mental illness and substance use stigma.
- Gives people an Action Plan to identify and respond to signs and symptoms of mental health and substance use challenges, including suicide.
- Increases mental health literacy.
- Increases confidence to provide strategies to help someone in both crisis and non-crisis situations, and knowledge of where to turn for help.
- Offers a safe place for participants to discuss their experiences.
- Teaches participants how to assess for suicide and refer to care.

Mental Health First Aid classes may be eligible for continuing education credits; inquire when registering. Training are free for those who live or work in St. Clair County. All others are welcome to attend for a \$20.00 fee. Must be 18 years or older.
